I've always looked forward to being a mother. I am in a place in my life where I can provide for a child both as a loving parent. I look forward to welcoming a child into my life!










I grew up in a close family that valued education. My parents instilled in me that every person is valuable and deserves kindness and respect.

My house has a big backyard, beautiful woods and fields, a pond for skating in winter, and a salt-water river for playing in the sand and learning to swim.




