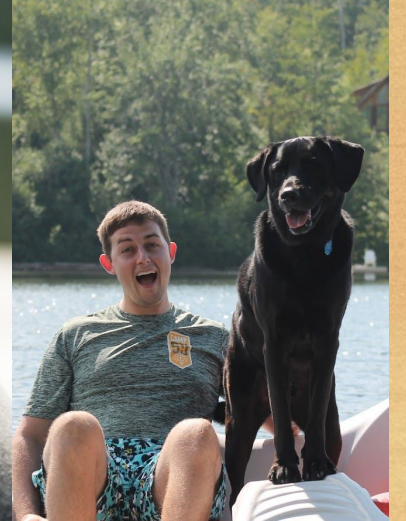

# Family and Friends





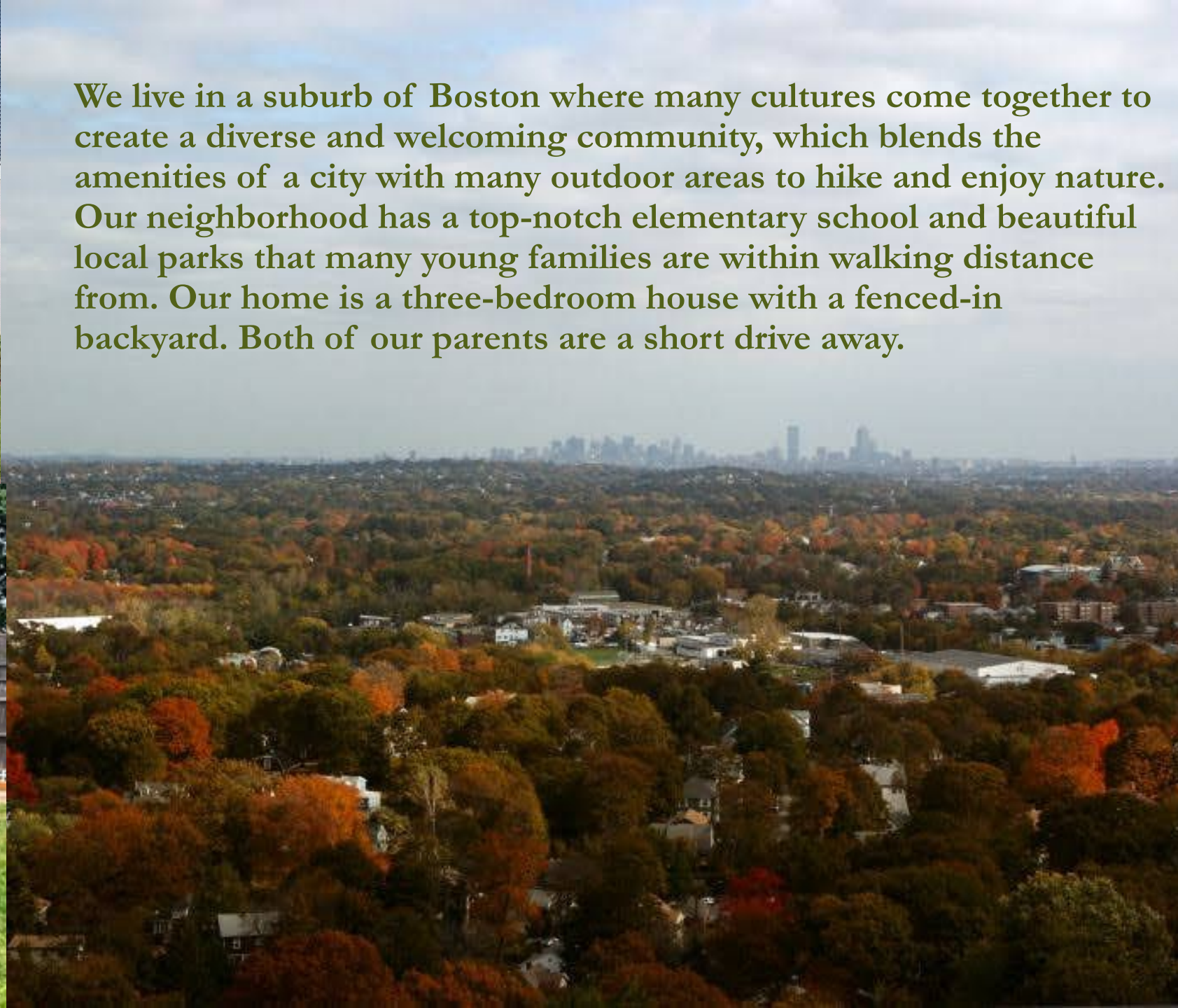
